The new ambulance was delivered on August 1 and the crews are working to stock it so we can put it in service. The modified cabinet layout will make it much easier to find supplies and will allow standardization with the other trucks.

The ambulance with the oil leak (med 75) problems is at Wheaton's getting the transmission fluid leak fixed. The torque converter was leaking fluid and should be fixed Friday (Aug. 5).

The District is still going over the budget and making more cuts to the EMS budget. There is another District Board / Budget meeting on Monday, August 8, to discuss the budget again. It is becoming difficult to find areas that can be cut to reduce the budget since there are very few areas we can make cuts. I am not sure if the District Board will consider including the station generator based on how they are trying to reduce the proposed budget.

Key Largo EMS was well represented at last Tuesday night's event – "National Night Out". A big "thank you" to those that attended is in order.

The air handler in the upstairs classroom/kitchen area had to be replaced; it was over ten years old and started to leak.
