This is in response to your letter dated September 19, 2011.


About a year ago, I first spoke with and then received a letter from attorney Joshua T. Hauserman regarding the topic of impact fees. (I gather from your letter that Mr. Hauserman has since left your firm.) At the time, I mentioned to Mr. Hauserman that Monroe County Fire Rescue had reported that several of their officers had actually been speaking with representatives of the District to get input on how to spend the impact fees that were on account at that time, and specifically where to locate the fire hydrants that were being purchased with those fees.

I have asked Monroe County Fire Rescue for updated information regarding the balance in the impact fees account and will provide it to you upon receipt. In the meantime, I will also get you updated information on discretionary sales surtax revenue.

In his letter, Mr. Hauserman mentioned an interlocal agreement between the County and the Village of Islamorada. My recollection is that I told Joshua that I was unable to find any such agreement and asked him for a copy. If you have located it, I would appreciate it if you could forward a copy.
