# Business Meeting Minutes April 10, 2012

Board members in attendance were Brenda Beckmann, Russ Cullen, Ronnie Fell, Jackie Harder, Tess Marra and Scott Robinson. A quorum was present. Also in attendance were Jack Bridges, KLVAC attorney and Bob Thomas, a candidate for a District Board seat. Membership attendance is reflected in the monthly attendance roster.

#### 1. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by President Ronnie Fell.

#### 2. Announcements

Tess Marra reported a balance of \$274,639.49. Jackie Harder motioned to approve the treasurer's report. Scott Robinson seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 5. Committee Reports

President Fell reported that the training mannequin has been ordered and should be here in a few weeks.

#### 6. Legal Report

Jack Bridges reported that the letter sent to DOT and the County (Commissioner Murphy) reference lighting at Publix had received a favorable reaction.

#### 8. Old Business

#### A. Number of Back Up Calls

President Fell reported the following number of back up calls for 2011: 167 total back up calls; 55 transports; 44 transports handled by KLVAC; 11 calls utilized fire department personnel. President Fell stated that there was probably no need to staff a back-up truck. Scott Robinson stated that most of the backup calls were on weekdays. President Fell suggested that members call the back-up medic if they are available to respond.
