Business Meeting Minutes September 11, 2012

Board members in attendance were Brenda Beckmann, Russ Cullen, Ronnie Fell, Jackie Harder, Tess Marra, and Scott Robinson. A quorum was present. Also in attendance were Jack Bridges, KLVAC attorney and Chief Donald Bock. Membership attendance is reflected in the monthly attendance roster.

1. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by President, Scott Robinson.

A. Budget Update

Scott Robinson reported that the Corps had kept to the 10% rate increase over last year's budget as requested by the District. The 3% paramedic pay raise and funding for the painting of the building were approved as well as funding for a proposed 401K plan.

Tess Marra reported that Edward Child, Eric Fundora, and Edwin Linares have accepted the nomination for Seat #4 and are eligible to run. Elections will be held at the next meeting.

C. Jerry Cunningham Scholarship Update

Brenda Beckmann reported that FKCC would handle the investigative details of the scholarship; i.e. application process, GPA, financial need. KLVAC would be allowed input also; i.e. stipulating the student would be chosen by a KLVAC committee, would be from the Upper Keys, would submit an essay, and KLVAC would determine how the money would be dispersed. It's been almost two years that we have not had all four units up and running. First it was the truck with the oil leak then miscellaneous items and next came the heater hose. I hope it lasts for a while.

The much needed pressure cleaning & painting of the ambulance building should start this month. The District Board agreed to use some left-over funds from this year's budget to start it and finish using next year's funds in October.

The budget is down to the number the District Board requested of ten percent over last year's amount. The ten percent over is because of the items that were "deferred" last year to this year's budget, like painting the building. There is a District Budget meeting at 6pm Monday night so it's still subject to change...

The electronic patient care software is progressing – tried some "beta testing" and found out what worked one day is not working now (transferring data from the ECG monitor to the laptop). One day at a time I guess, it has been a <u>very</u> long road but it is almost ready to be put into use in the field. I would rather find out now and fix it before we start using them as the only source of reporting (i.e. no more paper reports).

Scott and Ronnie have been doing a great job at the District meetings answering questions. Scott has been working on a LOSAP / 401K retirement program with Commissioner Tharp. Ronnie has been generating some interesting statistics for his reports and is working on this year's donation letter. CeCe has continued to go above-and-beyond in keeping the trucks stocked and running; especially when it comes to fighting with FORD. George is keeping up with the challenges of the schedule, even with a few tough days last month with the help of Tess, Bobby and the others that make this place what it is — devoted.
