Transition Update:

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- Sixty two personnel have filled out applications for the new fire department as of June 8, 2013.
 This included volunteers, paid staff, dive rescue team members and some administrative personnel.
- 2. Phil Jones, one of the full-time employees was hired by the Town of Palm Beach Fire Department and his last day was Thursday May 30. As a result the part-time employees were evaluated for his position and Chris Jones was the highest scoring person and accepted the full-time position. The three personnel that applied for the part-time position opening in the beginning of May were evaluated for the open part-time position created when Chris Jones moved to the full-time position. Fernando Garcia was the highest scoring person and accepted the part-time position. The evaluation process created was based on a 10 question oral interview (50%), State certifications and classes (25%), and time with Key Largo Fire, position held and time with other fire departments (25%). A three-person panel scored the individuals. The guys gave Phil a going-away dinner and a day he will remember.
- 3. Linda Newman has been working diligently getting the name changes done with vendors and the insurance policies. There is still uncertainty about the Workers' Compensation Insurance because the carrier (PSIG) said they are now going to drop all 501.c Corporations in October. Currently the Ambulance Corps. policy is covering the personnel. All other insurances were in place on May 26th. Linda is looking into the Liability Insurance to obtain quotes on higher deductibles and confirm the policy includes the most current assessment done.
- 4. The electric and water utilities have also been converted. FKAA charged \$20 per meter (3 meters) to convert to the new corporation name. FKEC waived the deposit fee (5 meters) as long as the bills are paid on time. The first time we are late paying FKEC we may be assessed the deposit fee of \$5,700. The telephones are still being worked out as are the internet/TV.
- 5. Three bank accounts were established; Payroll/Reimbursement, District Expenses and Corporate. The though being Corporate would be used for donation money and corporate related expenses. The District advanced \$25,000 and \$20 was put in the Payroll/Reimbursement account, \$5,000 was put in the District Expenses account in the Corporate account we received four generous donations: Kay Cullen gave \$1,000, Jack Bridges gave \$100, Bill Anderson gave \$100 and there was a \$50 cash donation. On-line banking is in the process of being established there is a ¾ inch stack of forms that need to be completed...
- 6. Wendy Dyer has agreed to do the accounting for the new corporation. Keys Accounting declined to give an estimate on accounting services stating that they were not interested in taking on the new fire department at this time.

- 7. I met with each one of the full-time employees individually and then later met with all full-time and part-time employees as a group to get their input and concerns. This also allowed me to get a better understanding of how things operate. A few changes have been made already and working together with the guys other changes will come as time provides. Overall, they're an awesome group of guys that are definitely dedicated. Morale has also begun to improve. I still need to meet with the volunteer officers to hear their thoughts and concerns.
- 8. Linda, James, Scott and I worked on the preliminary budget draft Friday. There were several line items we were able to cut money from and some we still need to research.

I would like to request that the following personnel be recognized for their hard work and dedication. They went above and beyond getting the new Squad 24 in service. Rather than buying new equipment mounts, they used the old mounting brackets and fabricated new ones by cutting up the old dividers (sheet aluminum and nylon guides). This resulted in a savings of over \$1,000. They spent over two full days working as a team to get the new Squad in service. Each day as I stopped by I observed these guys covered in sweat for 10 to 12 hours a day mounting brackets and organizing the equipment in the compartments to put the truck in service. James Griffeth and David Garrido did an awesome job coordinating the switch from the old Squad to the new one.

While the guys were working on it the second day, the new Squad responded to a motor vehicle accident and a reported structure fire with smoke and flames showing and the guys saved the structure. They also brought a puppy and a cat out alive. The fire was contained to the living room area and appeared to have started from an overloaded electrical cord. The smoke unfortunately filled the entire home making it unlivable. The fire was notice by a neighbor when the fire caused a window to break.
