Estate Tax Notices. Please note the line item for our District. We held the millage at the same level for 2010 as the prior year despite an approximate 20% decline in property values. In fact, we began the budgeting process by specifying this value and working through the line items of both departments and the district to arrive at it. Our reason for this "backwards" approach (vs. most other government entities) was our view that the drop in real estate values was a reflection of the local economy in general and not an isolated statistic. If people have less cash to spend, how do they afford the same taxes??
