# DISTRICT MEETING MINUTES APRIL 10, 2017 – FINAL

# 1. AGENDA

## 1.A. Call to Order

Chairman Allen called the District Meeting to order 6:00 p.m.

#### 2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA & MINUTES

## 2.A. Approval of April 10, 2017 Agenda

<u>MOTION:</u> Commissioner Mirabella made a motion to approve the April 10, 2017 District Meeting Agenda, which was seconded by Commissioner Powers. The Board unanimously passed the motion.

# 2.B. Approval of Minutes

## 2.B.1 Approval of Minutes of March13, 2017 District Meeting Minutes

Commissioner Thomas requested that Item 6.A. Stroke/Stemi Alert be revised to add the following statement: It was determined that the District and Department protocols were proper.

<u>MOTION:</u> Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve the March, 13, 2017 District Meeting Minutes as amended.

Commissioner Cullen seconded the motion, and the Board unanimously passed the motion.

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#### 6. OLD BUSINESS

## 6.A. DISCUSSION: Fire Hydrants

Commissioner Thomas reported the Phase 5 drawing #16-16 has been completed, and it is awaiting Fire Department approval. We need four more Phase 6 fire hydrant locations.

# 6.B. MOTION/APPROVAL: Fire Protection & Safety Grant (FP&S)

The District will apply for the FP&S Grant, which opens on April 17, 2017.

# 6.C. MOTION/APPROVAL: Alpine Software (Red Alert System) \$5,535.00

Chris Jones provided additional information about the Red Alert System. The estimated annual support fee is approximately \$4,000, and does not require a contract. The fee includes free upgrades and IT support.

<u>MOTION:</u> Commissioner Thomas made a motion to table this item until the next meeting. Commissioner Powers seconded the motion, and the Board unanimously passed the motion.

# 6.D. DISCUSSION/ACTION: Dive Team

Rob Bleser read a prepared statement to the District Board. Mr. Bleser requested the District return any equipment owned by him to him, and he would return equipment owned by the District to the District. Theron Simmons asked if a formalized agreement with the District and Department and the District and Dive Team could be developed. The Clerk was directed to contact FASD to inquire which insurance companies dive teams use. There was consensus among the Commissioners to move forward and seek a solution.

**MOTION:** Commissioner Thomas made a motion **for Legal and Finance to research any Insurance avenues for potential dive team and cost.** Commissioner Powers seconded the motion, **a**nd the Board unanimously passed the motion.

# 7.A. DISCUSSION: Items to be Included in Minutes

The minutes should be action oriented versus discussion oriented. Theron will work with the Clerk to review the minutes.

## 7.B. MOTION/APPROVAL: LaRocco RFP 17-001 Contract Change Notice #1

Commissioner Thomas reported the 2017-2018 ILA with Monroe County is for \$150,000 for the Phase 5 Fire Hydrants. To date La Rocco has billed the District \$141,750 for 15 hydrants, which leaves \$8,250 of the ILA unused. the projected cost of an additional hydrant is \$9,450. The balance of \$1,200 would come from the Unappropriated Fund Balance.

<u>MOTION:</u> Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve <u>RFP 17-001 Change Notice 31 to add fire hydrant #16-16.</u>
Commissioner Cullen seconded the motion, and the Board unanimously passed the motion.

# 7.D. DISCUSSION: Flood-Zone Designations

This item was tabled to the next meeting.

# 7.E. DISCUSSION/ACTION: Old PPE

Commissioner Allen requested the old PPE be saved for training.

# 7.F. <u>MOTION/APPROVAL</u>: Reynolds Engineering Proposal Phase 6 Fire Hydrant Drawings \$6,545

The funding to prepare the Phase 6 Fire Hydrant drawings will come from the Unappropriated Fund Balance.

**MOTION:** Commissioner Thomas made a motion **to approve the Reynolds Engineering Proposal to prepare the Phase 6 fire hydrant drawings.** Commissioner Mirabella seconded the motion, **a**nd the Board unanimously passed the motion.

## 7.G. MOTION/APPROVAL: Old Engine 24 Repairs (Approximately \$25,000)

**MOTION:** Commissioner Thomas made a motion **to approve the quote to repair Engine 24 in the amount of \$19,713.08** Commissioner Powers seconded the motion, **a**nd the Board unanimously passed the motion.

# 8. FINANCIAL REPORT

# 8.A. District Financial Report 170228

Finance provided the five-month financial report. The District is 41.67% through the budget year.

The District Board received total revenues of \$113,057 in February, and the year-to-date revenues are \$2,105,545 or 79.97% of budget. The District Board spent \$7,467 in February with the year-to-date expenditures totaling \$139,004 or 48.1% of budget.

The Fire Department spent \$137,899 in February, and the KLVFD year-to-date expenditures are \$1,079,798 or 53.75% of budget. Repairs and maintenance has a little high, and the new engine has been paid for.

The Ambulance Corps spent \$30,511, and the total year-to-date expenditures are \$252,261 or 41.19% of budget.

The total District expenses for February were \$175,878, and the total District year-to-date expenditures are \$1,471,065 of 50.55% of budget. There was a deficit of \$62,820 for the month, And a year-to-date surplus of \$571,896 which includes 1/4 of the set aside for the Vehicle Replacement Fund

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## 9. LEGAL COUNSEL REPORT

Theron reported both of the ambulances have been sold. The 2002 sold for \$9,650 and the 2008 sold for \$10,101. He recommended the Open Burn Ordinance be revised to add the definition of nuisance fire. The fire department requested if an item could be added about the dry season. The Board directed Legal to revise the Ordinance.

Ronnie Fell reported the Fire Department will be testing 25 people on April 22<sup>nd</sup>. One of the newly-certified firefighters has been hired by another department, and the department is awaiting paperwork for one firefighter.
